## EXTENDED CARE TEACHERS

This is a before and after school program that allows students time to play, restful quiet time, and in the upper grades, an opportunity to study. Work hours are from 7:30-8:15, 12:15-3:00, and 2:45-5:30, Monday through Friday, starting immediately.

Five extended care positions are available:

ONE TEACHER FOR PRESCHOOL EARLY MORNING EXTENDED CARE 7:15-8:15AM

ONE TEACHER FOR ELEMENTARY MORNING CARE 7:15-8:15AM

TWO TEACHERS FOR PRESCHOOL EARLY AFTERNOON EXTENDED CARE 12:15-3:00PM

ONE TEACHER FOR ELEMENTARY AFTERNOON EXTENDED CARE 2:45-5:30PM

The above roles offer the candidates, as teachers, the freedom to nurture the development and unique capacities of each child within the context of the whole class, according to the development of the child as outlined in Waldorf pedagogy and the works of Rudolph Steiner. As Faculty members, candidates will play an integral part in maintaining and determining the pedagogical and administrative aspects of the school.
